

# WALL.APP - COOKIE POLICY

The purpose of this document is to inform you about usage of cookie technology when you use the services of Shoonya Tech Ltd and its website <https://www.wall.app>.

The Website is developed by Shoonya Tech. Ltd, a tech. company having its head office in the Shoonya Tech Ltd. - Craigmuir Chambers, Road Town, Tortola, VG 1110, British Virgin Islands and is registered on the Register of Companies in the British Virgin Islands as a company limited by shares under the BVI Business Companies Act 2004 (hereinafter “**We**” or “**Shoonya Tech. Ltd**”).

## 1. WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small text files that are stored in your browser by websites that you visit. They are created for a limited time when a user’s browser loads a given website: the website sends data to the browser, which then creates a text file. Every time the user returns to that same website, the browser retrieves the file and sends it to the website’s server.

Data stored by cookies include the pages viewed, the type of browser used, your IP address, some identifier, and sometimes the information you entered on a website to save you having to enter it again.

They are widely used in order to make websites work or to trace your navigation for statistical or advertising purposes.

The tables below (**5. Table of Cookies**) detail the cookies we use and why.

## 2. HOW CAN YOU MANAGE COOKIES FOR WALL.APP ?

Cookie placement on your device is subject to your consent unless they are used solely to enable or facilitate electronic communication or are strictly necessary to provide an online communication service at your express request.

The first time you connect to the website, you receive information regarding cookies in an information banner that is visible at the bottom of your screen.

You may consent to the placement of cookies by clicking on the “**Ok!**” button on the banner.

Such consent will be valid for a maximum period of six (6) months.

You can withdraw your consent to the installation of cookies at any time.

**You can refuse the placement of cookies on your device by:**

Clicking on the “**Refuse non-essential**” button in the banner, or

Setting your choices in the cookie manager accessible from the “**Customize**” button.

If you have not done so from the banner upon arrival on our website, you can accept or reject cookies at any time via our cookie manager.

### 3. **WHAT ARE THE CONSEQUENCES OF REFUSING COOKIES?**

Disabling functional and necessary cookies will prevent you from using the website under normal conditions.

Disabling analytical cookies has no consequence on your use of the website.

### 4. **WHY DO WE USE COOKIES?**

Cookies have different purposes.

#### **Cookies necessary for the operation of the website and our services**

These are cookies that are necessary for the operation of our website or the services you request. They allow you to use the main features of our website (such as access to your account).

We do not need your consent for these cookies, but we need it for all the other cookies listed below.

#### **Functional cookies:**

These are cookies that allow us to provide you with certain features that are not essential to the service but that significantly improve your experience, such as adapting certain parts of our website to your device or proposing tools adapted to your use.

#### **Analytical cookies, necessary for audience measurement**

These are cookies that allow us to know the use, the volume of visits and use as well as the performance of our website. These cookies allow us to improve the interest, ergonomics and operation of the services offered on the website (for example, the pages most often consulted, searches by Internet users in the website's search engine, etc.).

## 5. TABLE OF COOKIES

Hereafter is a table of all cookies used on our website, we have indicated their name, their purpose as well as the third party who deposits them when they do not come from Shoonya Tech. Ltd. and their expiration period.
